Notes: When stating the width of a curtain please describe a single panel and tell us how many you have exactly like that (ex: 8 legs @ 18'h x 4' w; or main drape: 2 pieces @ 18'h x 24'w).

Fullness is determined by how much extra fabric is pleated into the drape. 100% fullness (typical amount) indicates a drape that is made from twice as much fabric as the webbing at the top. In other words, if you were to lay the drape on the floor and stretch it out, the bottom measurement would be approximately twice as big as the top measurement.

Limelight recommends the removal of all hooks and metal hangers before shipping drapery. Please call with any questions and to get an accurate estimate on the time involved for curtain restoration. Normal turnaround time is two to four weeks after receiving the curtains. Unforeseen circumstances may increase the time required for restoration.
